A carbuncle garnet and colourless paste set oval pendant and matching oval brooch, with a silver neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed 'Sterling', brooch width 2.2cm, length of pendant 3.5cm.

Condition Report

618. Suggested age is late Victorian. The original brooch fitting is missing from one cluster which is now converted for wear as a pendant. The suspension loop is probably in association with the oval cluster drop. One of the pieces is marked \blacklozenge 900 \blacklozenge at the back, the other unmarked. The border settings of the pastes are of differing designs and sizes. Although the two pieces are similar, they are not strictly a pair. The neckchain is later than the two pieces.
