A diamond and ruby brooch/clasp of circular form, mounted with a cluster of cushion shaped diamonds, the principal diamond at the centre within a shaped and pierced outer border, set with cushion shaped rubies and diamonds, diameter 3.3cm, total diamond weight approx 3.40ct, total ruby weight approx 0.40ct.

Condition Report

675. Cut: old European. Colour: approx H-I on average. Clarity: approx SI1-SI2 on average. The centre cluster looks to be in association with the outer border suggesting that this is two pieces of jewellery in association. The back clasp fittings are missing tongues and the central brooch pin seems to be a later addition. The fittings are extensively altered from their original construction. Weight 13.6g.
