A Victorian 15ct gold, diamond, ruby and red gem set brooch, decorated with a beaded border, Birmingham 1892, width 4cm, with a case, and a late Victorian 9ct gold and blue enamelled brooch, detailed '1837 1897', commemorating the Diamond Jubilee, centred by a crowned heart, width 4.5cm.

Condition Report

682. Ruby/diamond brooch: the diamond has numerous internal inclusions and looks to be replaced in the setting. There are lead solder repairs at either end of the lengths of the ropetwist wirework. There are some repairs to the edge beading. The brooch has been over gilded in the past. Blue enamelled brooch: there is a lead solder repair by the pin hinge evident from the front of the brooch. The hook to the clasp is gilt base metal and has been reposition in the past. There is a large chip and surface marks to the blue enamel. There is a claw missing at the bottom of the heart. 15ct - weight 3.9g; 9ct - weight 3.8g.

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
