A pair of Chinese blue and white porcelain cylinder vases, mark of Kangxi but late 19th century, each painted with prunus, underglaze blue four character mark to bases, height 26cm, together with four similarly decorated porcelain baluster vases and covers, heights 27.5cm to 31cm (some faults).

Condition Report

1176. 1st cylinder vase - vertical haircrack to body and small chip to rim. 2nd cylinder vase - badly broken and glued with small section missing from rim. 1st baluster vase - neck broken and glued, cover chips. 2nd baluster vase - neck cracked and with chipped out section, small chips to cover. 3rd baluster vase - faint starcrack to neck, chips to cover. 4th baluster vase - ok.
