A Paragon China Queen Mary pattern part dessert service, circa 1920, decorated with a central floral bouquet within the gilt overlaid cobalt blue rim with cream ground floral panels, comprising two tazze, a square serving dish and ten plates, green printed factory marks to bases with Waring & Gillow stamp and 'Reproduction of service accepted by Her Majesty The Queen on her visit to the Potteries April 22nd 1913'.

Condition Report

1474. Some overall typical light surface wear, but generally decoration in good order. Square serving dish - crazed, with small chip to underside of rim. Plates - one plate cracked, one plate crazed. Tazza - one has small hairline crack and crazing to foot, other one in good condition. Otherwise in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
