A Royal Worcester blush ivory harlequin part service, 1903 to 1909, decorated with floral sprays within gilt rims, comprising two cake plates, a teapot and cover, nine teacups and eleven saucers, eleven tea plates, a sugar bowl and a milk jug, various green and puce printed and painted factory marks to bases, together with two matching Graingers Worcester teacups (some faults and repairs).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1470. Teapot - only minor crazing and typical wear to high points and base, otherwise no chips, cracks or repairs. Cups - one repaired with visible glue residue, another with small manufacturing fault to footrim, others in good condition. Saucers - one with minute chip to footrim, other in good condition. Sugar bowl and milk jug - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Tea plates - one hairline cracked, others in good condition. Cake plates - good condition. Overall only very minor light surface wear/scratches, more evident on cake plates but generally in great condition.
