A Mason's Ironstone iron-red ground vase and cover, mid-19th century, the octagonal high shouldered body enamelled and gilt with scrolling flowers and foliage, flanked by cobalt blue and gilt dolphin handles beneath the domed cover with entwined dolphin finial, unmarked, height 50cm. Note: a similar shaped vase is illustrated by Geoffrey Godden, 'Godden's Guide to Mason's China and The Ironstone Wares', p.186, pl.287.

Condition Report

1479. Area of professional restoration to one corner of cover and small area of flange which sits inside vase when cover is in place. Two minute pinhead sized glaze nicks to dolphin finial of cover. Three minor vertical haircracks to rim of vase, longest approx 3cm. Otherwise in good condition with light surface scratches and typical enamel wear/flaking.
