A Chinese Canton export ivory brisé fan, mid-19th century, the guards carved in relief to each side with figures, the twenty-one sticks carved in low relief and pierced with scenes of figures, animals, trees and pavilions framing an oval monogrammed panel, length 19.5cm (minor faults).
