A Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jar, Kangxi period, the ovoid body painted with four barbed panels alternately filled with precious objects and blossoming branches, height 17.5cm (reduced neck and drilled hole to base), together with a wood cover and stand.

Condition Report

1151. Neck reduced and with chip to inner rim edge. Drilled hole to base. Some spots of glaze loss to surface of main body. Hardwood cover doesn't fit properly, is missing finial and has losses to the flange. The stand is okay.
