A set of four George III and later silver and mahogany candlesticks, each silver reeded urn shaped sconce with detachable nozzle, on a mahogany reeded stem with central knob and circular base, the sectional sconces with part marks including maker's mark of Daniel Smith & Robert Sharp of London, one later sconce London 1848 by C.S., heights 29cm to 30cm (some faults and repairs).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

470. There is some slight variation in sizes to the silver mounts in the sconces and circular mounts beneath. All four mahogany stems and bases match with some minor chips but otherwise okay. Some of the silver mounts have part marks but impossible to see on all as some do not screw off. One silver sconce has had a solder repair and some misshaping and dents to nozzles and sconces.
