An early Victorian silver gilt child's rattle with foliate engraved decoration, hung with two bells and fitted with a coral teether, Birmingham 1840 by George Unite, length 8.5cm (one bell detached but present, and faults), together with two gilt metal slide action pencils.

Condition Report

413. Silver gilt rattle is rather misshapen and damaged and missing most of its bells. Coral teether is snapped. Gilt metal propelling pencil - minor wear but in working order. Gilt metal hexagonal propelling pencil - wear and dents to exterior, otherwise in working order.
