A large Royal Doulton jardinière, early 20th century, the cylindrical body decorated with classical figures and motifs against a brown glazed ground between the ochre glazed foot and rim with Greek key detail, black printed factory mark to base, height 26.5cm.

Condition Report

1421. The jardinière is heavily crazed overall, some of these craze lines can be felt with your nail. The glaze to the exterior would appear compromised as it has a blotchy white appearance which despite cleaning does not go away, it almost looks like mildew. There are some noticeable scratches to the body exterior and some minor areas where the glaze is lacking to the footrim and top rim - these are manufacturing issues.
