A pair of impressive Chinese hardwood armchairs, late Qing dynasty, each back inset with a circular dream stone marble panel, the grey and black inclusions resembling mountain ranges, within a finely carved and pierced surround of scrolling cloud-like ruyi heads, the rectangular panelled seat flanked by a pair of similarly carved and pierced open arms, above an apron with low relief meandering scrolls, raised on block legs united by stretchers, the underside of each seat with black painted characters, height 106cm, width 71.5cm.

Condition Report

1050. Both chairs in generally good condition. No significant damage or repairs, few minor chips/nicks. One has a split across the seat, both have some slight gaping at the joints so some re-gluing would be beneficial. Both marble panels in good order. Nice quality pair of chairs.
