A pair of Chinese green hardstone carvings of Buddhist lions, 20th century, each modelled in a seated pose, height 9.5cm, together with a Chinese blue and white export porcelain tea caddy and cover, late Qianlong period, painted with landscapes within gilt borders, height 13cm, and a Japanese antimony dish, moulded with a monkey mask and leaves, length 15.4cm.

Condition Report

1057. Both Buddhist lions in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Caddy has a two-section piece of neck which has been broken and re-glued and a small chip to the shoulder. Cover also chipped to rim and section of inner rim broken and missing. Antimony dish - overall good condition but some wear to patina.
