LOT 2001

An early 19th century Anglo-Ceylonese ebony and specimen inlaid hexagonal centre table, the top inlaid in various exotic woods within a carved foliate border above a single frieze drawer, raised on carved acanthus leaf double scroll supports united by a platform base, height 72cm, width 55cm (some minor faults).

Estimate: £500 - £800

Condition Report

2001. The top has had some movement to the carcass wood resulting in some loss to the inlaid veneers and a few cracks. The loss of veneer is mainly to the chequered stringing between the specimen wood panels, there is also some renewing of some of the chequer banding. Otherwise there is a screw in the side of one support and some chips to the edges of the feet, some minor scuffs and marks.
