A Japanese Satsuma earthenware incense burner and stand, Meiji period, modelled in the form of a bamboo and pine grove, the trunks and canopy pierced and inhabited by birds, picked out in greens, yellow, brown, aubergine and gilt, indistinct impressed signature to base, total height 20cm (minor faults).

## Condition Report

1225. A 3cm firing crack to edge of the base. Typical light crazing and wear to gilt around the base. The pierced cage has numerous small chips to leaves. Tip of one bird tail has chipped off. Few glued repairs to leaves. Overall otherwise generally good order.
