A late 19th century silver gilt mounted faceted cut glass double ended scent bottle, each hinged and screw cover mounted with a circlet of coral beads framing an engraved monogram and 'Nelly', the interior of the hinged cover detailed 'Hunt & Roskell', otherwise unmarked, length 15cm (one coral lacking), together with a Continental .800 silver mounted figural moulded glass scent bottle with hinged cover, length 11.5cm. Provenance: from the estate of the late Nellie Lenson-Smith (1928-2017).

Condition Report

451. Victorian double end - glass in good condition with no chips or cracks. Some surface scratches and cloudy within. Both silver gilt tops have heavy wear to gilt and only traces of the gilt remains. Hinge end has one missing half coral and engraved monogram, hinge is good. Other screw end in generally good order but threaded mount needs re-attaching to glass. Other figural bottle - in good condition. Glass in good order. Hinge lid has a couple of very small dents but otherwise in good condition.
