LOT 2805

A 17th century Continental silkwork and metal thread ecclesiastical panel, depicting an angel holding a cloth, possibly representing the Veil of Veronica and depicting the face of Jesus Christ, within a wide band of scrolling tendrils and flowerheads, all worked in coloured silks, silver and gilt thread and embellished with foil bands and sequins, 36cm x 32cm, later mounted within a gilded frame.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2805. There is some overall browning and typical fading of colours. There are some areas of deterioration to background above angel, a hole in the veil and some further areas of damage in other areas. Some loose areas and loss to foil borders. Loss to the angel's right hand and some loss of threads to surface of some of the tulips. External measurements of frame 56cm x 52cm. It is glazed.

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
