A diamond, sapphire and blue gem set brooch, designed as an arrow, mounted with cushion shaped diamonds, calibre cut sapphires and blue gems, circa 1910-1920, length 9cm, total diamond weight approx 1.30ct (probably converted from a jabot pin), with a case.

Estimate: £400 - £500

Condition Report

520. Cut: old European cut diamonds and square cut sapphires. Colour: sapphires are mid-blue, diamonds are approx H-I, faint to medium fluorescence on average. Clarity: diamonds are approx SI1-SI2. Carat: sapphire 3ct total, 0.10ct each stone. The diamonds have one or two pique inclusions but are generally attractive white stones. The sapphires are of medium bluey green colour saturation. There is a solder joint evident 2.3cms behind the head of the arrow. The mount is white gold, probably 18ct. Weight 12g. Box is not original.

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
