A Victorian gold and citrine single stone circular brooch, the back glazed with a locket compartment, circa 1890, diameter 3.7cm, and a gold mounted blue stained crocidolite brooch, the mount with a bark textured finish, circa 1960, width 5.3cm.

Condition Report

540. The front of the brooch is in good condition. The hook to the clasp is a later replacement with the use of lead solder. There are two or three dents to the back of the rim. The crocidolite is in good condition apart from one shallow dent at the back. Weights 12.9g and 20.8g.
