A gold and rose cut diamond set pendant brooch, the centre with heart shaped motif and coronet surmount, mounted with the principal rose cut diamond with two supporting birds to the sides and three flowerhead shaped motifs above, probably first half of the 19th century, length excluding suspension loop 3.4cm.

653. Cut: old mixed cut diamonds. Clarity: SI1-I1, strong fluorescence. Colour: varying dark shades. Carat: very approx 0.50ct-0.60ct. In fair condition commensurate with age: NOTE: the backs of the diamonds are closed and therefore the carat weight is very approximate. Weight approx 10.1g.

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
