A Renaissance Revival enameled, pearl and gem set pendant, last quarter of the 19th century, designed as a peacock with a blister pearl drop, otherwise spaced with small baroque pearls to the chain, length including suspension loop 7.5cm, on a curb link neckchain with cylindrical clasp.
