A gold and enameled oval pendant, one side decorated in relief with a bust portrait of a gentleman in an early 17th century design, the other side with a cross and scrolls, length including suspension loop 2.4cm, together with a small gold mounted oval shell cameo brooch, depicting the bust portrait of Pope Pius VII, length 1.7cm.

Condition Report

673. Enameled pendant: there is some loss of gold work to the back of the head. There is considerable loss of enamel work to either side. There is some attempted restoration work to the enamel when viewed from the back. The suspension loop mounting at the back is later replaced. Cameo brooch: in fairly good overall condition commensurate with age. Weights 4.8g and 1.5g.
