A Wedgwood ruby lustre small footed Marston bowl, 1920s, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, gilt with butterflies, mother-of-pearl interior, gilt printed Portland Vase mark to base with pattern No. 'Z4827', diameter 9.8cm, together with a smaller blue lustre bowl, pattern No. 'Z4829', diameter 5.7cm, and a Doulton Wright's Coaltar Soap dish.

Condition Report

1565. Ruby bowl - starcrack primarily visible to interior with one branch running from rim. Areas of white visible to exterior predominantly above foot and with other lesser scratched spots to exterior sides. Blue bowl - in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Soap - 3cm long horizontal firing crack to green edge, minor chip to underside edge of one wing. Spot of glaze loss to green edge. Glaze frit to tip of butterfly tail. Surface scratches to blue glaze.
