A Wedgwood Argenta Ware majolica Punch and Judy teapot and cover, circa 1880, the ivory glazed body with Mr Punch handle terminal, Judy spout and Toby the dog cover finial, impressed and painted factory marks to base with numerals '2786', length 19cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

1420. Overall fire crazing to glaze with light staining to interior. Branched starcrack visible to base interior with some other slightly more noticeable hairlines amidst the crazing to the base. Four starcracks to body of pot, two to one side, one around handle terminal and one to other side above footrim. Glaze loss to edge of spout and tip of handle thumbrest. Approx 1cm square chip to rim above spout, minor chipping to flange where cover sits in one spot at spout end. Three small firing cracks along edge of cover.
