A Montereau Leboeuf Milliet & Co. faience pottery jardinière, late 19th century, decorated in relief with opposing panels of putti within a garden, flanked by grotesque mask handles, raised on a tapering circular foot, impressed factory mark to base, height 23.5cm.

## Condition Report

1540. There is crazing to the glaze predominantly visible to the underside and interior. The interior has some staining and a branched haircrack to approx half of the base interior - not visible to the exterior. The jardinière has obviously housed a plant pot as there is dense surface wear to the rim interior at the narrowest point. There is no restoration or chips and the exterior is in good order with very very minor glaze loss to extremities. Overall height 23.5cm, diameter of foot 16cm, interior diameter at narrowest point 14cm, diameter between handles 25cm.
