A pair of George V silver mounted cut glass globular scent bottles, Birmingham 1911 by Synyer & Beddoes, together with five other silver mounted cut glass scent bottles.

Condition Report

381. Spreading foot pair - typical chips and knocks to glass. One silver collar detached from base, both a bit bruised/misshapen. Stoppers appear to be original but one missing all of stem and other badly chipped. Clear hallmarks. Rectangular pair - typical chips to glass. One missing screw fitting, both missing stoppers. Small dents/bruises to covers but readable hallmarks. Globular pair - minor chips to glass. One stopper missing. One hinged cover detached. Hallmarks rubbed. Dents and bruises. Oval bottle - hinged cover detached. Hallmarks rubbed but readable. Missing stopper.
