A Victorian silver double-ended rat tail medicine spoon of table and teaspoon size, London 1885 by James Wakely & Frank Clarke Wheeler, length 20.3cm, together with a late 19th century Continental silver Shell pattern tablespoon, the front with heraldic eagle motif, maker's mark 'I. Wagner & S' to back of stem, length 22.5cm.

439. Medicine spoon - small scan mark visible to stem, presumably from manufacture. Hallmarks clear, light rubbing to maker's mark. In good condition with light typical wear. Engraved monogram to stem quite rubbed. Continental spoon - good condition.
