A late 19th century French brass novelty mantel timepiece in the form of a lighthouse, the movement contained within the body of the tapering cylindrical column, the front with white enamel circular dial, the balance wheel formed as the glass rodded 'light', with glazed surround, dome surmount and pierced balustrading, on a square base, height 24.8cm.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1135. Overall case is in generally good condition but it is a bit dusty and has some minor surface wear. On the gallery, one of the pierced fretwork side panels is missing and has been replaced with a solid panel. The movement does not run but the balance wheel is free but not working. No key.

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
