An English porcelain harlequin part tea service, circa 1820, decorated in the Imari palette with fruiting branches, including a teapot and cover and a sucrier, cover and stand, probably Coalport, and various cups and saucers (some faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1449. Items with more iron red detail - Teapot stand - ok. Teapot - spout chipped, stamark to body. Two plates - crazed but ok. Sucrier - stained but ok. Nine teacups - four ok, three ok with light staining. Nine saucers - seven ok. Eleven coffee cups - ten generally ok with some light staining predominantly to handles. Other set - Teapot stand - minor restoration. Sucrier - cover restored, otherwise ok with crazing and light wear. Two plates - one restored, other worn. Slop - restored. Nine teacups - six restored, three ok with wear. Fifteen saucers - eleven restored or with hairlines. Four ok but with wear.
