A silver cased keywind open-faced pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with a cylinder escapement, scroll pierced and rose diamond set balance cock, detailed to the back plate 'Ellicott London 8453', signed and numbered dust cover, the enamelled dial with Roman numerals, London 1841, case diameter 4.2cm.

Condition Report

1020. Case has wear but otherwise sound condition. Both hinges are good. Dial is generally in good order but has a couple of insignificant bruises to edge. Movement is fairly clean but it does not run.

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
