A silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, pierced and engraved balance cock, the backplate detailed 'Willm Smart London 83916', the enamel dial with black Roman numerals, London 1807, outer case diameter 5.5cm, together with another silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the backplate detailed 'L Lewtirp London 586', the outer case London 1819, outer case diameter 5cm.

Condition Report

1074. Smart watch - outer case is a bit worn with typical surface scratches and a few minor dents, otherwise generally good order. Inner case - numerous small dents and back of case and some wear. Dial has a small chip at 6 o'clock beside the catch, otherwise good clean condition. Movement is clean and is in working order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Lewtirp watch - outer case has some substantial dents and tear to back of case and button is missing. Inner case has numerous dents and wear to back. Dial has a couple of tiny little chips to edge. Movement looks fairly clean but not in working order.
