A silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, pierced and engraved balance cock, the backplate detailed 'Davison London 1825', the enamelled dial with black Roman numerals, London 1796, outer case diameter 5.7cm, together with another silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the backplate detailed 'Pegler Blandford 4472', London 1828, outer case diameter 5.7cm.

Condition Report

1072. Davison watch - outer case has some dents to back of case and typical light scratches, otherwise good order. Inner case has a few dents and wear and hinge is a little loose. Dial has a crack at 11 o'clock, otherwise in good order. Movement looks fairly clean but it does not run. Pegler watch - outer case has a deep dent to back, missing button and typical scratches. Inner case has a few dents, typical scratches and wear. Dial has few minor chips to edge at 6 o'clock and a small hairline. Movement is fairly clean and it is currently working in working order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
