A silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, pierced and engraved balance cock, the backplate detailed 'F. Shuttleworth 14843 Avon', the enamelled dial with black Roman numerals, London 1794, outer case diameter 5cm, together with another silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the backplate detailed 'Abraham Levi Hastings 15923', London 1860, outer case diameter 5.7cm.

1071. Shuttleworth watch - outer case in typical fair condition, surface scratches and minor dents. Hinge is good. Inner case in good condition with engraved monogram to back. Dial in generally good order, few light scratches and tiny chip to edge. Levy watch - outer case has numerous dents, has been split and repaired. Inner case has typical wear and scratches, otherwise ok. Dial is good and clean. Not in working order.
