A gold and cornelian intaglio ring, carved as two mythological birds with a chariot, otherwise with bead motifs to the interlooped shoulders, probably mid-19th century, ring size approx I1/2, and a paste intaglio ring, the intaglio moulded as two birds, as converted from a seal to a ring, detailed '9ct', ring size approx I1/2.

Condition Report

628. Cornelian ring - good condition but some surface wear and scratches. Not hallmarked, would suggest 9ct. The other ring has had a repair to frame and area is discoloured. Marked 9ct. Weights 3.7g and 6.8g.

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
