## LOT 1140

A late Victorian oak stick barometer with mercury thermometer, the dial with twin angled ivory vernier scales, the carved case with anthemion surmount and broken arch pediment above a pair of Ionic columns and shield shaped cartouche, height 115.5cm.

Estimate: £200 - £400

## Condition Report

1140. Very good quality oak stick barometer that is difficult to fault. Everything appears to be working and almost no damage. There are a couple of very minor chips at the case corners. All mercury, both in the barometer and the thermometer is intact. The only thing is that the plates (ivorine we think) are slightly stained, as they always are on this period of barometers.
