A mid-18th century silver repoussé pair cased open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, probably of North European manufacture, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, squared architectural pillars, scroll pierced bridged balance cock, the back plate detailed 'Charles Cabrier London', the inner case detailed 'LAQUE', the silvered dial with black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minute numerals, the centre inscribed 'Cabrier London', the outer repoussé case decorated with a classical scene within a surround of rococo scrolls, signed 'D. Cochin F', outer case diameter 5.3cm.
