## LOT 1084

A mid-18th century silver repoussé pair cased open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, probably of North European manufacture, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, squared architectural pillars and pierced bridge balance cock, the backplate detailed 'Wilton London', the inner case marked 'L.B' within a stylized coronet, the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minute numerals, the outer case decorated with a cast classical scene within a surround of rococo scrolls, outer case diameter 5.2cm, with a key.

Estimate: £200 - £300

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## Condition Report

1084. Outer case - generally good condition, typical minor wear to high points. Inner case - typical light surface scratches and few minor dents. Small repair to hinge. Movement looks fairly clean but watch is not running. Few chips to edge of dial.

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
