A Continental pottery slipcast model of a seated monkey, late 19th/early 20th century, on a naturalistic rock base, incised maker's signature 'M? Trivelt' to side of base, height 33cm.

Condition Report

1560. Fire haircrack to body running from forehead over left eye, across top of nose under right eye, down side of right face, across top of right knee and branches into two directions down side of right leg where it disappears. It is not immediately noticeable and is only really visible across the face. There is an even fainter possible haircrack probably emanating from the same place down the left side of the body. Again not very noticeable. Neither detract from the object really.
