A pair of French rectangular purple tinted glass vases, early 20th century, each decorated in gilt with poppies, height 21cm, together with a small group of other glassware, including a Lalique frosted glass lid, decorated with roses, a pair of Bohemian cranberry spill vases and a green tinted vase (some faults).

## Condition Report

1518. Purple pair - the more delicate gilded foliage on each vase has almost totally worn away, shadows of it remain. One vase has an approx 1cm square chip to one corner of the top rim edge which has been painted over in gold. Otherwise ok with typical light wear. Green vase - minor nick to top rim edge. Cranberry pair - small nicks/chips to extremities of one primarily. Cover - just a cover, not marked, approx 1/3 section of rim edge badly chipped away.
