A group of glass decanters and stoppers, early 19th century and later, including a set of four graduated rectangular decanters, each with gilt garland decoration to the shoulder, and three examples engraved with fruiting vines.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1491. Gilded decanters - gilding typically rubbed. Stopper jammed in one of the smaller decanters, otherwise ok. Engraved square decanter - chip to rim. Hobnail decanter - chip to body and bruises to stopper. Triple ring neck decanter - chipped end of stopper. Shaft and globe decanter - badly chipped neck. Otherwise remaining items generally ok.
