An early 20th century French brass and champlévé enamel four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the gilt chapter ring with Arabic numerals and inscribed 'Edward & Sons Glasgow', the backplate with stamped Japy Frères maker's mark, above a mercury compensated pendulum, the oval case with bevelled glass panels and enamel foliate borders, height 28cm, with winding key.

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

1166. This clock is in overall good condition. No visible damage to case, enamel or glass. Mechanism is complete and appears to be willing to run but would benefit from a clean. Mercury tubes dirty. Japy Freres movement.

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
