A late 19th century French brass mounted tortoiseshell mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the circular enamel dial with Arabic numerals and flower festoons, the case with carrying handle surmount above urn finials and foliate borders, on a rectangular base and foliate feet, height 32.5cm, with a pendulum.

## Condition Report

1168. Case is in overall sound condition. Small amount of tarnishing to the brasswork. Minor chip to tortoiseshell on left hand base panel. Larger piece of tortoiseshell missing from lower rear of the case. Two finials not secure. Dial and hands in good condition. Mechanism appears to be working but would require a clean. Some rusting to the gong. Movement stamped with maker's mark, 'Marti'. Original pendulum but no key.
