A rare Sussex pottery slipware flagon, dated 1777, of elongated bulbous shape with three bands of an impressed chain motif to the neck above the impressed dotted date, the loop handle with dotted edge and terminal, height 43cm (faults). Note: the present owner believes there is only one known piece of Sussex pottery dated earlier than this.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

1510. Missing support on body opposite handle above date. Chip to side edge of handle. Most of footrim chipped away. Otherwise fundamentally in good order with typical areas of glaze loss/wear/surface scratches overall. There are a number of blemishes to the glaze overall which are predominantly since manufacture, to the right of the handle is a carved blemish which almost suggests something is missing since manufacture or got stuck to the flagon during firing.
