## LOT 1459

A Bohemian cranberry flashed and cut goblet, second half 19th century, the hexagonal body engraved with floral and classical emblem panels above the knopped stem and petal shaped foot, height 17cm, together with a circular glass bowl with applied green and yellow trailed detail beneath the plated rim, diameter between handles 26.3cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

## Condition Report

1459. Bohemian goblet - number of very minute nibbles to the high points on the petal foot, with some small losses to the edges of the cranberry decorated circular panels. Some typical, but heavy, wear to underside of petal foot, otherwise the goblet is in generally good condition. Glass bowl - number of chips to the ends of the yellow trailing decoration nearest the base, with typical surface scratching to the underside of the base and to the high points on the trailing decoration. The plated rim is also worn, otherwise in good condition.
