An 18ct gold cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt three-quarter plate movement detailed 'Detach'd Lever No 19161', sprung dust cover, 18ct gold inner case, the cream coloured dial with gilt hands and centre seconds, the case back engine turned framing a shield and garter cartouche, Chester 1852, case diameter 5cm.
