A large Italian maiolica oyster dish, late 19th/early 20th century, of circular shape with central armorial decoration, surrounded by twenty-four shell depressions and a raised edge, supported on a circular foot, unmarked, diameter 45.5cm (minor faults).

1425. 6.5cm hairline crack to rim. 1.5cm x 1cm chip to rim and 4cm hairline crack running down from this. Numerous small chips to rim, but no significant damage, colours are nice and bright.
