## Condition Report

309. Overall in generally good condition. It is, however, a little worn. The cover has enamel band in good condition and typical light surface wear. It has part marks to the side (lion passant and date letter). Interior looks to have been re-glued. Sides of box are a little worn and have a few minor dents and have no visible hallmarks.
