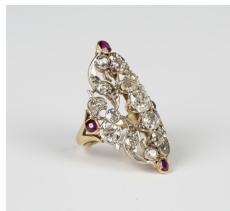

LOT 645

A diamond and ruby cluster ring, the raised central section mounted with a row of five graduated cushion shaped diamonds within a pierced scrolling surround, set with smaller cushion shaped diamonds and four cushion shaped rubies, ring size approx M.

Estimate: £600 - £900

Condition Report

645. Overall ring is in good clean condition. An impressive ring with good bright sparkly diamonds. Under magnification some minor surface abrasions and inclusions to diamonds are visible. Gold mount and shank in good order with typical surface wear and scratches. The central row of five cushion shaped diamonds is likely to be in association with the rest of the ring and may have come from a bar brooch. Shank is 2mm at narrowest and 3mm at shoulders. Otherwise generally good clean condition. Panel is 3.5cm x 2.2cm. The ring is 20th century. The gold is not hallmarked but looks better than 9ct. The main diamonds are fairly white bright stones but all slightly included. Approx 2.5ct total diamond weight.

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
