Condition Report

308. Top panel - small repaired chip to top right hand corner. Small chip to right edge halfway down. Small bruise/nick to purple cloud in top left corner. Typical light surface scratches. Blue side panels - in generally good order but there are a few shallow chips to corners of some panels. Otherwise box is in good condition with good detail and hinge is good. Hallmarks good and clear.
